Dear Members,

As April approaches, your golf course maintenance staff will be in full swing. The golf course seems to be coming in well from the winter with just a few damaged areas that we are addressing. On April 4th through the 8th the staff will begin the greens aerification combined with deep tinning and dryjecting. Dryjecting is a process in which a hand driven machine uses a high power injection to shoot sand into the green profile. This will help drain the greens of water much faster than we have before and it will also give the root system a much need boost. I am very excited that we are doing this process here at High Meadows and I believe that this is a good first step toward protecting your greens for the future.

Also as the month goes on your staff will be tackling the ditch on hole number 6. Our goal is to soften the slope and make that area of the fairway much more player friendly.

I hope to see you all very soon on the golf course and should you have any questions please stop me and ask. Once again I am looking forward to a great year and I hope to see all of you very soon around the course.
