Tip of the Month - Having trouble from thick rough!

It would be nice to always find your ball in the middle of the fairway, but we all approach our ball at times and find it in a thick rough lie. Hopefully this tip will help with this issue. First adjust your ball position by moving the ball more towards the center of your stance. Second and more importantly use more loft!! Regardless of the distance to the hole, the primary goal is to get the ball airborne, out of the rough and back into play. This may mean laying up to an area as opposed to going for the green. Too often we see players using to little of loft in an effort to hit the ball as far as possible. This actually prevents you from advancing the ball as far as you could with a more lofted club. Please try this approach and call the Golf Shop if you are having trouble with your game!!
