From the Greens Committee

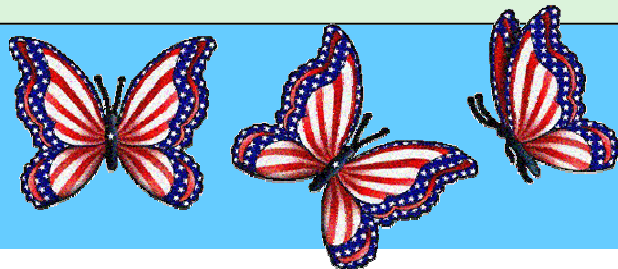
HMCC Golfing Members:

It will not be too long before the tee and bunker renovation is completed. Preserving the appeal of this work will of course be up to the golf course maintenance staff and all golfing members. Listed below are a few items that should be followed, for the good of the club, during the renovation work and some after completion.

- 🦋 Please do not hit from sodded areas.
- 🦋 Please do not walk over sodded areas except to retrieve your ball, especially the newly sod areas.
- 🦋 Presently sand traps on holes #s 4, 5, and 6 are in play; all other sand traps are not.
- 🦋 Keep carts on paths only adjacent to the tees. Do not drive up next to the tee.
- 🦋 Keep carts 10-15 feet away from sodded areas and sand traps.
- 🦋 As always keep carts 30 feet from the greens.

Please check with the pro shop before your rounds to see if any additional holes, newly sodded areas or sand traps are in play. Also remind your playing partners and others if they are not adhering to the above. If they persist, please advise someone in the pro shop, we've all invested in the renovation project, let's all work together to protect our investment.
